Student Smoking In The Stadium

The Spokane Public High Schools have a vigorous anti-smoking program in the schools. Its effectiveness is indicated by a survey taken last year among high school seniors, which revealed that only **one senior high boy in seven smoked and one senior girl in sixteen smoked.**

The U. S. Public Health Service, in a statement on August 21, 1967 reported that latest research findings reached three main conclusions:

1. Cigarette smokers have substantially higher death and disability rates than non smokers.
2. Many early deaths would not have occurred if the victims had never smoked.
3. Without cigarette smoking "practically none" of the early deaths from lung cancer would have occurred.

The vast majority of Spokane students believe that the dubious distinction of showing off by smoking a cigarette is not worth the ultimate price to be paid by the smoker.

In conjunction with the city-wide anti-smoking program, the high school athletic league asks that no high school or junior high school student smoke in the Stadium.
